Works: Limited to unpublished works created by the artist themselves (works exhibited at TABUROU Art Association branch exhibition, solo exhibition, group exhibition, etc. are acceptable)

If copyright or portrait rights are found to have been infringed, the award and submission will be cancelled.

Size: Size 20 to Size 200 (minimum 72.7×50 cm, maximum 259×259 cm) Number of works: Up to 3 works per person(within size 300 in total)

Entree fee(public offering): 8,000 yen for adults

5,000 yen for students

(those who have completed compulsory education)

Entree fee will not be refunded for any reason.

Framing: Please make sure to frame your works(glass frames are not accepted, acrylic frames are acceptable).

Scope of responsibillity: We are not responsible for any accidents, disasters, or loss of the exhibited works (including frames and acrylic surfaces).

Delivery expenses: All packing fees, shipping costs, unpacking fees, etc. for the works will be borne by the exhibitor.

Notes: Exhibited works cannot be removed during the exhibition, regardless of reason.
