

Nationwide Open Call 59th Taburou Art Exhibition Submission Regulation

The Taburou Art Association welcomes artists' free ideas and expressions, encourages mutual improvement of creative motivation and expression, and aims to broadly develop art and culture. The Taburou Art Exhibition is a forum for artists to present the creative works they have built up, and we are holding this exhibition in search of artists who will pursue their own creative endeavors and hone their skills with each other.

1. **Name:** Nationwide Open Call 59th Taburou Art Exhibition
2. **Organizer:** Taburou Art Association
3. **Period:** June 10th(Wednesday) to June 22nd(Monday), 2026 10:00~18:00 (entry until 17:30)
Closed on June 16th(Tuesday)
Last day until 15:00(entry until 14:30)
Admission fee: General admission: 500 yen
Free for students with student ID
Free for disable people and up to two attendants with presentation of a disability certificate
4. **Venue:** The National Art Center, Tokyo Gallery 3B

5. **Category:** Oil painting, Japanese painting, watercolor painting, other two-dimensional painting.
6. **Regulations:**
 - ① **Works:** Limited to unpublished works created by the artist (excluding works exhibited at the Taburou Art Association branch exhibition, works submitted to solo exhibition group exhibition, etc. are acceptable.)
If copyright or portrait rights are found to have been infringed, the award and submission will be cancelled. In this case, entree fee will not be refunded.
 - ② **Size:** Size 20 to Size 200 (minimum 72.7cm×50cm, maximum 259cm×259cm)
 - ③ **Number of works:** Up to 3 works per person (Total size within 300)
 - ④ **Entree Fee:** Pubric entries: 8,000 yen Students: 5,000 yen(Compulsory education or above)
 - ⑤ **Framing:** Please frame the works to protect them. However, frames with glass are not allowed as they may be damaged, but frames with acrylic are acceptable.
Please make sure to attach a hanging hook or string to the back of the work.
 - ⑥ **Scope of responsibility:** We are not responsible for any accidents, disasters, or loss of the exhibited works (including frames and acrylic surfaces).
 - ⑦ **Packing, unpacking and delivery costs:** All costs are borne by the applicant.
 - ⑧ **Notes:** Exhibited works cannot be removed during the exhibition, regardless of reason.
7. **Carry-in:**
Date and time: May 29th(Friday) and May 30th(Saturday), 2026 11:00~16:00
Reception location: Enter through the loading entrance of The National Art Center, Tokyo and go to the "Nationwide Open Call 59th Taburou Art Exhibition" reception desk at the entrance to the loading/unloading area on the first basement floor.
 - You cannot enter through the main entrance.
 - Please be sure to take the packaging with you.
 - If you are sending them to a delivery agent, please be sure to write "Nationwide Open Call 59th Taburou Art Exhibition" in large letters on the outer packaging materials.
8. **Judging:** External judges: Mr. Yasutomo Shimizu(Art critic), Mr. Jun Teshigawara(Art critic)

9. **Award:** Awards will be given to outstanding works.

Reception location: Same as Carry-in, The National Art Center, Tokyo "Nationwide Open Call 59th Taburou Art Exhibition" reception desk at area on the first basement floor.

Any items not picked up by 17:00 will be kept by Saibido.
